ARGENTINA STUDY ABROAD SPRING 2020

- **Argentina Spring 2020:** Engage in a high impact program.
- SMC students in a cohort will collaborate with University of Belgrano students to create a capstone project: a health campaign.
- During the second half of the Spring 2020 semester, this program will include a 3-week study abroad program in Argentina, led by Dr. Lourdes Arévalo.
- SMC students in the study abroad cohort will enroll in a **Spanish 20** (Latin American Civilization – 3 units), **Spanish 99** (Experiential Learning – 1 unit, a hybrid **Media 20** (Intro to Writing and Producing Short Form Media – 3 units), and an online **Health 60** (Multicultural Health and Healing Practices – 3 units). Interested students may also enroll in a hybrid **Spanish 8** (Conversation – enrollment is optional in this 2-unit class)
- Students in the cohort live with Argentinean families during their stay in Buenos Aires.
- Cohort students will share their study abroad experiences with classmates who won't go abroad.
- This study abroad program will include field trips to various sites in Argentina.
- (Approximate cost: \$3,800 including airfare, room, breakfast and dinner, and insurance. Recommendations will be provided regarding financial aid and fundraising. Tuition, fees and books not included in approximate cost.)
- Intermediate proficiency in Spanish required by Spring 2020.
