



### PROGRESSION AGREEMENT

## UNIVERSITY OF ESSEX

Wivenhoe Park, Colchester, Essex CO4 3SQ, United Kingdom ("Essex")

and

### **SANTA MONICA COLLEGE**

1900 Pico Boulevard, Santa Monica, CA 90405, United States ("SMC")

## **Preamble**

This Progression Agreement (this "Agreement") is intended to enable Essex and SMC to pursue the Objectives (specified in clause 1 below) by undertaking the Tasks (specified in clause 2 below), all as set out below.

## 1 Objectives

- 1.1 Essex agrees that students from SMC who meet the admissions criteria set out in **Schedule 1** may be eligible for admission to degree courses at Essex, subject to each applicant from SMC providing written evidence of attainment of their academic qualifications.
- 1.2 For the avoidance of doubt Essex shall have absolute discretion in respect of the admission of any students and nothing in this Agreement shall bind Essex to admit any student referred to in **clause 1** of this Agreement to any of its degree or other programmes.

## 2 Tasks for each Party

- 2.1 Each Party agrees to maintain regular and reasonable contact with the other Party, informing the other Party of any proposed relevant changes or developments in relation to this Agreement;
- 2.2 SMC agrees it shall market and promote Essex's courses (outlined in **Schedule 1**) to its own students provided always that such promotional material complies with any brand guidelines issued by Essex from time to time in respect of the use of such name and/or logo and is subject to prior written approval as aforesaid.

# 3 Costs

- 3.1 The Parties agree that each shall bear its own costs for any work under this Agreement, save and except as agreed in writing between the Parties. For the avoidance of doubt, each Party shall meet the travel, accommodation and subsistence costs of its own staff involved in any visits associated with this Agreement.
- 3.2 No fee is payable by Essex to SMC in respect of any person who applies to or is accepted by Essex to any of its programmes pursuant to this Agreement or otherwise.

# 4 Commencement and Duration

- 4.1 This Agreement commences on the date it has been signed by an appropriate officer of both Parties ("**Date of Commencement**"). Either Party may withdraw from this Agreement at any time during the term of this Agreement by giving at least three months' notice in writing to the other Party.
- 4.2 This Agreement shall be in effect for five (5) years from the Date of Commencement. This period may be extended by written consent of both Parties. In the absence of any extension then this Agreement shall automatically terminate with no further liability by Essex.
